Subject:

Disturbances in Government offices during office hours.

The hours of work in all State Government offices are from 10-30 a.m. to 5-30 p.m. with an interval of 30 minutes from 2 p.m. to 2-30 p.m. for tiffin. It is imperative that all Government

employees observe these working hours.

It has come to notice that the facility of the tiffin break of 30 minutes from 2 p.m. to 2-30

p.m. is sometimes misused. This break is primarily meant for eating tiffin. If for any reason it

becomes necessary during tiffin break to hold a meeting, it cannot extend to interfering with those

who are working during this time by shouting slogans or demonstrating in the corridors or inside

offices.

It has also been observed that on some occasions meetings have been held during regular

office hours apart from the tiffin break of 30 minutes. It is needless to reiterate that this is not

permissible under any circumstances.

All Government employees should observe the above stipulations and co-operative in their

enforcement so that the right atmosphere is maintained in all Government offices.
